

PROCEEDINGS OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, JUNE 9th A. D. 1911.

Board met pursuant to adjournment of yesterday, Roll call showing present Commissioners D. C. Jones, and W. A. McKay, Dee J. Wren Clerk.

Proceedings were had as follows to wit:)

The matter of Pro-Rate of Taxes between Routt County Colo. and Carbon County, was taken up and fully discussed, and the County Clerk is hereby authorized to submit all the data ect, concerning same to Treasurer of Routt Co. as per agreement between the representatives of the Boards of County Commissioners of each County at a meeting held at Craig Colo.

The County Clerk is hereby instructed to go to the County Seat of Sweet Water and adjust the pro-rata of taxes between Sweet Water and Carbon Counties.

Hon. Frank A. Hadsell appeared before the Board on matters concerning the roads of Carbon County, and particularly roads to be worked by <sup>State</sup> prison inmates, saying ' Having had an interview with Governor Joseph M. Carey I will state it is very essential that the Board be represented at a meeting requested by the Governor, with him in regard to working convicts on public roads. He is very anxious to demonstrate the feasibility of working the convicts on these roads and expresses his desire to make the demonstration in Carbon County, near the Penitentiary, and that he has invited the Commissioners of the several Counties within the State to confer with him in regard to the convicts working the public Roads and in case some action was not taken in the immediate future it is not improbable that it would be impossible to get them at a later date during the year of 1911. Consequently I recommend immediate action.'

The foregoing being considered the Board hereby authorizes Commissioner W. A. McKay to attend such meeting mentioned above, and act as representative of this Board.

There being no further business before the Board, adjournment was made to June 26th A. D. 1911. to meet as a Board of Equalization, as is proscribed bylaw.
