

PROCEEDINGS OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS , SEPTEMBER 27. 1916.

Board met at 8 o'clock P. M. this 27th day of September A. D. 1916, in Special Session for transaction thereof of urgent business relative to a proposed co-operative road under the Federal Shackelford Bankhead Good Roads Bill.

Roll call showing present, Commissioners Robert A. Day, Ivor Christensen and L. B. Magor, Clerk. Commissioner Mc Kay absent. In the absence of Chairman Mc Kay, Commissioner Robert A. Day was chosen Chairman Pro Tem.

Road
A delegation of resident tax-payers from Encampment and vicinity presented petitions, signed by a large number of citizens of the County, that immediate action be taken by the Board of Commissioners in the co-operation of Carbon County and the Government under the above act to construct a proposed co-operative road through the Hayden National Reserve within Carbon County, Wyoming between Encampment and Savery, Wyoming.

It was resolved by the Board that the County Attorney draft an application in conformity to said ^{act/}and the same to be submitted to the Board for its approval not later than 28th day of September, 1916.

The Meeting adjourned to 2 o'clock P. M. September 28th. 1916.

Board met at 2 o'clock P. M. this 28th day of September A. D. 1916, pursuant to adjournment of September 27th. 1916. Roll call showing present, Commissioners Robert A. Day, Ivor Christensen, and L. B. Magor, Clerk. Commissioner Mc Kay, absent.

In the absence of Chairman Mc Kay, Commissioner Robert A. Day was chosen Chairman Pro Tem.

The Board being in session a draft of the Proposed Co-Operative Road through the Hayden National Forest Reserve under the Federal Shackelford Bankhead Bill, was presented to the Board for its approval, the terms and conditions thereof then and there being fully discussed by the Board.

On motion by Commissioner Christensen and seconded by Commissioner Day and carried, the said draft of said proposed road, being duly executed, was further ordered that a copy of said draft be and the same is ordered filed with the County Clerk of Carbon County and the original together with three copies, be forthwith forwarded, by registered mail, to the District Forester, at Denver, Colorado.

All business being attended to the Board adjourned to meet in Regular Session on October 3rd. 1916.
