THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION WAS PASSED ON BY THE BOARD.

WHEREAS, The State Board of Equalization failed to notify the Board of County Commissioners of Carbon County, of the amount of tax levy for the year 1921, for the maintenance of the State University, and

WHEREAS, the said Board of County Commissioners have levied all State taxes of which it received notice from the State Board of Equalization, and

WHEREAS, on Dec. 8th, 1921, said Board of Commissioners of Carbon County, were by telegram from C. L. Draper, Chairman of said State Board of Equalization, notified to assemble and direct the Assessor to so amend the Tax Roll as to make the same show an addition of three-eighths (3/8) of a mill levy, for said University maintenance, and

WHEREAS, said Board of Commissioners of Carbon County, having made its tax levy for State and County Purposes at the time and in the method as by law provided, and having adjourned said Board, WHEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that said Board of County Commissioners of Carbon County, Wyoming, refuse to make said levy as requested by the Chairman of the State Board of Equalization, for the reason that no legal provision of the Wyoming Statutes authorized or confers the legal right to do so.
