

SPECIAL MEETING, AUGUST 2nd, 1935

Road

Petition by residents of Elk Mountain and Hanna, for the establishment of a road, between said places was filed herein, on July 27, 1935 and was duly considered by the Board, whereupon it was found upon motion duly seconded and carried that said road petition is in proper form, designated by the Surveyor's description in metes and bounds thereof and that it is signed by more than ten electors of Carbon County who reside within fifteen miles of the proposed road; that attached thereto is a list of all owners, mortgagees and lien holders of the land traversed by the proposed road; that a plat of said proposed road, described as Cb-42 Elk Mountain-Hanna road, having been accurately surveyed and platted by the Wyoming State Highway Department, on motion moved, seconded and adopted it was decided to dispense with the survey thereof, by the County Surveyor and to adopt the survey and plat thereof, of said Department, the same having been filed on August 2nd, 1935, and duly signed and approved by S. S. Sharp, County Surveyor of Carbon County, Wyoming.

On motion duly made and carried Frank Schilt was appointed viewer of the proposed and described road, and was requested at his earliest convenience to view same and report to them as required by law.

No further business appearing before the Board at this time, meeting was adjourned until Tuesday, August 6th, 1935.
