

SPECIAL MEETING.

The Board of County Commissioners met this 8 day of August A. D. 1939, at 10:00 o'clock A. M. for the purpose of hearing protests on proposed re-location of Wamsutter-Rawlins road.

Protest and objection to the establishment of a road, known as Wamsutter-Rawlins road having been filed by the Union Pacific Railroad Company, The City of Rawlins and Espy and Larson, by D. P. Espy, at a meeting of the Board of Commissioners held on August 8, 1939, at the office of the said Board in Rawlins, Wyoming, the following motion was made, to wit:

"Motion by Commissioner McCarthy, seconded by Gooldy and unanimously carried, that J. F. Mahoney, Arthur Rasmusson and W. L. Niland be appointed appraisers, to view and appraise the said Wamsutter,-Rawlins road and to make report of their findings to the Board of County Commissioners on or before Sept. 7th, 1939." which motion is duly recorded in Book 9 of Commissioners' Proceedings at Page 367 thereof.
