

## COMMISSIONER'S PROCEEDINGS

## SPECIAL MEETING

The Board of County Commissioners met Feb. 5, 1940, at 10:00 O'clock A. M., all Commissioners present, Fred F. Hansen presiding.

Pursuant to Section 6, Chapter 87, Wyoming Session Laws, 1939, a public hearing was held relative to the proposed Carbon County budget for the year 1940.

On the recommendation of the budget officer, the following changes were made in the budget.

Budget proposal for Election expense raised from \$5000.00 to \$6500.00.


Budget proposal for Court House and Jail raised from \$10000.00 to \$10600.00, reduction was made in Miscellaneous General budget of \$2100.00 to balance the above changes.

At the request of County Surveyor, S. S. Sharp, the surveyor's budget was reduced in the amount of \$65.00, and budget of the Water Commissioner increased \$65.00.

There being no protest filed, motion was made by Commissioner Gooldy, seconded by Commissioner McCarthy, that the proposed budget as revised be received by the County Commissioners.

On motion regularly made and seconded meeting was adjourned until Feb. 6, 1940.
