

COMMISSIONERS' PROCEEDINGS

SPECIAL MEETING.

The Board of County Commissioners met this 20th day of March, A. D., 1940, at 2:00 o'clock P. M., all members being present, Fred F. Hansen, Chairman.

A motion was made by Commissioner Gooldy and seconded by Commissioner McCarthy, adopting the following resolution.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the County road known as the Baggs Poison Butte Basin road adjacent to Baggs, Wyoming and running through Sections Thirty-one (31) and Thirty-two (32) in Township Thirteen (13), Range Ninety-one (91) and Sections Thirty-six (36) in Township Thirteen (13), Range Ninety-two (92) and Sections One (1), Two (2), Ten (10) and Eleven (11) in Township Twelve (12) Range Ninety-two (92) has been designated and platted as a County Road, and

WHEREAS, the Civilian Conservation Corps is desirous of improving and maintaining said County road, and

WHEREAS, the Civilian Conservation Corps has established a camp for the purpose of their operations, and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners of Carbon County are desirous of abandoning the said Baggs Poison Butte Basin road.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that the County Commissioners of Carbon County in session on the 20th day of March, 1940 hereby abandon the road known as the Baggs Poison Butte Basin road running through Sections Thirty-one (31) and Thirty-two (32) in Township Thirteen (13), Range Ninety-one (91) and Sections Thirty-six (36) in Township Thirteen (13), Range Ninety-two (92) and Sections One (1), Two (2), Ten (10) and Eleven (11) in Township Twelve (12) Range Ninety-two (92) and that the same is hereby abandoned as a County road.

There being no further business to come before the Board, motion was duly made and seconded that the meeting be adjourned subject to the call of the Chairman.
