The Board of Commissioners met on November 20, 1946 at 10:00 a. m., Commissioners McCarthy and Cheesbrough present, Gooldy absent.

It was called to the attention of the Board of Commissioners that Justice of the Peace Jacob Waeckerlin was in ill health and it was suggested that with the approval of Judge Waeckerlin, William N. Brimmer, Justice of the Peace elect, be appointed to fill the unexpired term of Judge Waeckerlin.

It was moved by Commissioner Cheesbrough, seconded by McCarthy and so carried, that William N. Brimmer be appointed as Justice of the Peace for Justice Precinct No. 1 to fill the unexpired term of Justice of the Peace Waeckerlin effective November 20, 1946.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned subject to the call of the Chairman.

The Board of Commissioners met on November 22, 1946 at 10:00 a. m., all members present.

SAVERY-STATE LINE HIGHWAY:

A motion was made by Commissioner Gooldy, seconded by Cheesbrough and carried, that the Wyoming Highway Department be requested to make an immediate survey of the road from Savery east to the State line following the location of the present road as nearly as possible.

COMMUNITY ROOM:

The Commissioners' attention was called to the damages in the Courthouse by various groups using the Community Room. Children have been allowed to run over the building and sponsors of the different organizations have not supervised their actions. On many occasions the elevator has been operated for long periods when the sheriff's office and others have needed it for important reasons.

It was decided by the Board that future telephone reservations of the Community Room would be discontinued and that anyone wishing to reserve this room would be required to sign a register in the County Clerk's office in order that confusion in reservations be avoided. This would also provide a closer check in preventing damages and needless waste of courthouse supplies.
