

## Baggs Solid Waste Disposal District

### Board Member Position Description

#### Term:

3 year term (except when filling an unexpired term) with a maximum service of 12 years.

#### Purpose:

The overall mission of the Baggs Solid Waste Disposal District is to provide waste and recycling disposal to members within its district boundaries pursuant to the applicable provisions under the Wyoming law. The district is also responsible for the day-to-day operation of the Baggs Solid Waste landfill.

#### Criteria:

Board members are required to fill out an application, pursuant to the requirements of the Carbon County Commissioners, to be appointed to an open position on the board of directors. It is the preference of the directors that new applicants possess the following skills:

- To willingly serve effectively as a public representative of the organization and promote the mission, goals and objectives of the special district to increase public awareness, understanding and support of the organization.
- Possess professional expertise and influence that brings diversity to the board and the constituencies.
- Demonstrate significant leadership capabilities in the community and be willing to provide that expertise to the board and landfill operations.
- A commitment to spend four to five hours per month studying and evaluating issues and to become informed and prepared to discuss and vote on issues facing the special district.
- An ability to make decisions on issues, policies, priorities, goals and objectives.
- An ability to nominate and make an election of members and officers of the board.
- Monitor and evaluate the effectiveness of the projects and programs and assure these projects and programs are progressing towards their objectives.
- Approval and monitoring of the financial operations of the special district.

#### Time Demands:

A monthly board meeting on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Monday of every month.
